



All stands which are not conform to the exhibition regulations are subject to be modified by the organiser during the setting up.

❗ IMPORTANT :

When the exhibitor signs his/her admission request, s/he agrees to abide by all clauses contained in the “General Regulations” and “Exhibition Regulations” and to ensure that all decorators and contractors abide by them. The general regulations laid down by the “Fédération Française des salons spécialisés” (French Federation for specialist exhibitions) may be obtained on request from: EXPOSIUM - Fax 33 (0)1 53 30 95 29, please you indicate the concerning exhibition.

1. Hall floors, pillars and walls

It is strictly forbidden to drill, screw, nail or embed in the walls, partitions, pillars and floors of the halls; attaching machines to be exhibited to these elements is also forbidden. A fixed sum of 500 €/excl. tax per hole will be charge to the exhibitor for non-compliance with these regulations. Exhibitors must not paint or mark on the walls, pillars and floors of the halls. Weight allowance on the floor: illimited.

Your stand area must be restored to its original condition. Any rubbish (carpet, adhesive, etc.) must be removed. Any damage reported during disassembly of the stand will be invoiced to the exhibitor responsible. The exhibitor is personally responsible for his/her suppliers: decorators, installers, contractors, etc...

2. Setting-up of stands and presentation of exhibits

Exhibits on display must not disturb or damage neighbouring stands. No exhibit may exceed the surface area of the stand.

3. Acoustic Animation

The maximul sound level must not exceed 80dB (A) – in a 2,5 meter area surrounding each stand and this without any exception, even for a short period.

To avoid any disputes contact the organiser the day before opening for the calibration of your installation.

4. Electrical fittings on stands

For obvious reasons of safety, it is strictly forbidden to use the Exhibition Centre's private installations (hall raceways, water gutters, etc.) as a passageway for the stands' electrical cables. Only the technical services of the Exhibition Centre are authorised.

5. Hight of construction – Restricted area

Maximum height : 2,50m

All construction or decoration items set up at the edge of the stand, which are over 2.5 m high and within the 5.00 meters limit above the building floor must be positionned 1 m away from the neighbouring stand

6. Partitions and constructions bordering the aisle

Sides of offices, décor or panels facing towards the neighbouring stands must be smooth, plain coloured and painted or covered with M1 fireproof mural fabric.

It is forbidden to erect a wall or screen made up of partitions or office sides that impairs the overall view of the show, or hides the neighbouring stands. For this reason a 2.50 m wide opening must be established every 4 m.

Maximum height is 2,50 meters. Mid-height partitions or barriers limiting public access to equipment in operation are permitted, but these must not exceed 1.10 m in height, and must comply with the safety and evacuation standards in force.

7. Sign / Light brackets

The sign must be positioned at a level between 3 and 5 meters from the floor. The top of the sign or its structure must not be higher than 5.5 m above the building floor. The sign must not extend beyond the space of the stand, and must not be closer than 1 m to the neighbouring stand.

8. Lighting

The use of revolving or flashing lights is forbidden.

9. Covering of pillars

A maximum height of 5.00 meters from the floor. It can be supported by the pillar, but must be separated or, at the very least, insulated with soft material (felt, hardboard, sponge, etc.) placed over the points of contact.

10. Hanging of frameworks

This work may be carried out only by the Exhibition Centre Services. Please contact The Exhibition Centre Management for further details.

11. Raised level / Regulation

(see N°5). Address two copies of the plans and calculation notes for the resistance (two months before the show) to Gilles Crespon – Comexposium.

The maximal height of the construction must not exceed 5 m. It is forbidden to cover the premises and upper parts of the raised level.

A retreat of 1 m to the adjoining limits of the stand has to be respected. It is strictly forbidden to dispose any fitting above the aisles (structure or signboard, bridge, light brackets...).

12. Use of gas containers

The number of gas containers must be kept to a minimum. Their on-stand storage is strictly forbidden. Their connection and fixing to the machine is obligatory. The use of empty or fake bottles is to be preferred whenever possible. Empty or fake bottles must be identified and marked by the exhibitor.

13. Leaflets

It is strictly prohibited to distribute leaflets, flyers or any other such material outside the stands or in the areas around the halls (reception gallery, car parks and square).

14. Working equipment

See Form to make your declaration. All equipment displayed in working order during the exhibition must be declared to the Organizer. Exhibitors accept full responsibility for all presentations and demonstrations made by them, under penalty of being inactivated. Nevertheless, only machines and equipment certified by the Safety Commission as being in accordance with the regulations will be authorized to be displayed in working order.

15. Equipment in motion

Whenever equipment is presented in motion, a protected area should be reserved for these maneuvers so that there will always be a minimum distance of 1 meter between the equipment and visitors; this minimum distance may be increased according to the characteristics of the equipment on display. These regulations will be valid for all stands, including stands located outdoors.
